





Our Great God

What do we need to know about
our **Great God**?

I. Our Great God is the Lord

“This is what the LORD says, he who made the earth, the LORD who formed it and established it—the LORD is his name

(Jeremiah 33:2)

What does the name “the Lord” imply?

- “Let them know that you, whose name is the LORD - that you alone are the Most High over all the earth.”
(Psalm 83:18)

Most High God

- Supremacy
- Exaltation

God's greatness is

- **Incomprehensible**

- Great is the LORD and most worthy of praise;
his greatness no one can fathom.

(Psalm 145:3)

**A God whom we could understand
would be no God.**

**If we could grasp Him,
He could not be infinite.**

He could not be divine**

II. Our Great God is an Ever-Living God

‘Call to Me and I will answer you’

(Jeremiah 33:3a)

**4 But their idols are silver and gold,
made by human hands.**

**5 They have mouths, but cannot speak,
eyes, but cannot see.**

**6 They have ears, but cannot hear,
noses, but cannot smell.**

**7 They have hands, but cannot feel,
feet, but cannot walk,
nor can they utter a sound with their throats.**

(Psalm 115:4-7)

**O you who hear prayer,
to you all men will come.**

Psalms 65:2

“call” Hebrew root word ‘qara’

- **specific request**
- **specific person**
- **specific expectation**
- **specific answer**

- Turn to our Great God from our idols

- “Call on Me and I will answer you.”

III. Our Great God is Mighty

**‘and I will tell you
great and mighty things,
which you do not know.’**

(Jeremiah 33:3b)

“Great and Mighty Things”

"Fortified ones"

- Protected & safeguarded**
- Cannot easily be come at**
- Difficult of understanding**
 - Things reserved**

What are some great and mighty things God has showed?

“Ah, Sovereign LORD, you have made the heavens and the earth by your great power and outstretched arm. Nothing is too hard for you...Great and mighty God whose name is

the Lord Almighty,

¹⁹ great are your purposes and mighty are your deeds.

(Jeremiah 32:17-19)

26 Then the word of the LORD came to
Jeremiah: **27** **“I am the LORD, the God of all
mankind. Is anything too hard for me?**

(Jeremiah 32: 26-27)


